All Scouts are invited to a weekend of Orienteering. It will be a great outdoor adventure. All scouting units (Cubs, Webelos, Boy Scouts, Venture Scouts, Girl Scouts, and their adult leaders), will learn and practice map and compass skills, and can work on orienteering related badge requirements.

Where: **Camp Tuscazoar, 6066 Boy Scout Rd. NE, Dover, Ohio**

*Participants are welcome to camp for the weekend,
or just attend for Saturday's full slate of activities.*

EARLY MORNING: opportunities for scouts to receive instruction from expert orienteers.

LATE MORNING, INTO EARLY AFTERNOON: scouts can complete 1 or more courses to have fun and work on their skills.

LATE AFTERNOON: NORTHEAST OHIO SCOUT ORIENTEERING CHAMPIONSHIPS -- Scouts (as well as adults!) will compete with other scouts of the same rank or age level. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each class.

DUSK: exciting short Night-O score course leading to a Campfire

CAMPFIRE: Skits, songs, cheers, and the awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in each of the categories, as well as the Unit winners.

PIG GIG MEAL!!!! The **NORTHEAST OHIO SCOUT ORIENTEERING CHAMPIONSHIPS** are being held the weekend of the Camp's annual Pig Gig, so as an added bonus, all paid registering scouts, both youth and adult will receive a ticket for the Pig Gig feast, to use either Saturday or Sunday.

AUCTION: Scouts accumulate points throughout the weekend for their Unit. Those points can be used by the Unit to bid on items at the auction.

PRE-REGISTRATION MANDATORY: All Units must pre-register and pre-pay. It is expected that scouts will register as Units (troops/packs/crews). Scouts who want to participate without the benefit of a Unit in camp can do so by jointly pre-registering with another scout, or with their parent, and an adult must be in Camp for the entire activity. Mark the appropriate box on the pre-reg. form.

PRE-REGISTRATION DEADLINE: August 29, or 250 scouts, whichever comes first. Early

registration is encouraged to lock in your reservation. Pre-registrations received after the deadline, or at capacity, may be declined and returned.

Timely pre-registration is needed so we have the time to print maps and assemble the packets of materials in advance.

WE GO RAIN OR SHINE. Maps can be placed in plastic bags. Scouts can dress for the weather.

PATCHES: Custom designed event patches will also be provided to all who pre-register and pre-pay.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY: Each participant must have his or her own signed Waiver of Liability form that can be downloaded from the website, or sent to you by requesting one from ScoutsOrienteering@gmail.com. **These must be brought to the event and handed in at check-in.**
