

Dover Dam Weekend – Camp Tuscazoar - Animal Science MB - logistics



All groups will be given a **set schedule** that will allow them to complete all requirements, plus tour the Dover Dam. Signed **blue cards** should be turned in at check-in. For those who complete the requirements, the blue cards will be returned, signed by the counselor, Saturday evening.

To get to Rivercrest Farm, scouts will cross Boy Scout Road at the Camp Entrance, and **walk the trail marked by streamers** all the way to the Farm (with work to be done on the way). It is expected that **hayrides may be available for the trip back** to the Camp after the scouts have completed the Rivercrest classes.

The Requirements

Requirements 1 – 4: *Dr. Shawn Ryan, D.V.M.*, a veterinarian with the Sugarcreek Veterinary Clinic, will cover these requirements in a presentation in the Kimble Dining Hall. Scouts will be encouraged to stretch their legs during a *short* break.

Requirements 6b, c, & d: Along the trails to Rivercrest Farm and the Dam, information will be posted that scouts must review and copy. The Scouts will be provided with blank sketch paper. SPLs and/or patrol leaders may want to gather & redistribute the papers as needed. Scouts may want to bring something hard to write on (e.g. notebook or clip board). Signed completed sketches must be turned in at Kimble between 4 and 5 p.m.

Requirements 5 & 6a: *Deanna Vickery*, of Rivercrest Farm will present these in a class at the Farm with the aid of a few of her long-haired friends. She can also discuss 6d if needed.

Requirements 6b & c, & 7: *Dean Pugh* has decades of professional experience in animal science and is a long-time volunteer with 4-H. He will share his expertise on these requirements at Class Room 2 at Rivercrest Farm.

Question & Answer (& Reward): The tradition of a review session lives on. Join us at the Hoover Amphitheater (or Kimble if it's raining). Questions from the materials taught throughout the day will be asked. Those who learned their lessons and who are brave enough to raise their hands will be justly rewarded.

Dover Dam tour – *Stanlee Rosenblatt* and his crew from the United States Army Corp of Engineers will conduct tours of the historic Dover Dam. Be on time. If early, and there's room to join an earlier tour, go ahead, *but only if you're not cutting in front of a group that should be on that tour!!!!*
