SCHEDULE for Orienteering Activities

FRIDAY

8:15 pm to 8:45 pm – All O-MB participants and leaders gather in Dining Hall for Class. Refreshments provided. Mini-cracker barrel.

8:45 pm – Class starts no later than 8:45 and lasts about an hour.

SATURDAY

8:00 am – Check-in for single day participants.

8:40 am – **Flag raising** will begin promptly! Central camp or Museum (TBA)

9:00 am – Classes and courses begin.

1:15 pm – First Aid Class at Hoover Amphitheater (Req. #1)

2:15 pm – Cross Country courses debriefing at Hoover Amphitheater (Reg. 7b)

2:45 pm – Score Course map distribution and discussion.

3:00 pm – Deaver's Challenge begins at Hoover Amphitheater (likely 2 hr max., but TBA)

5 to 5:30 pm – Finish Deaver's Challenge at Jamboree Lodge.

5 – 6:45 pm – Head to dining hall for PigGig feast!

7:15 pm – Retreat at Central Camp.

8:00 pm – Deaver's Challenge review and overall review.
Announcement of the best times & scores. Hoover Amphitheater.

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The Orienteering Merit Badge

Req. 1 – Standard first aid requirements for outdoor MB's. Class available at **1:15 pm at the Hoover Amphitheater** (rain location is dining hall).

Req. 3 – Standard compass instruction for most scouts. Instruction available from **9 am to 11 am at Jamboree Lodge**.

Req. 5 – Pace course, including level and incline, set up in **central camp** for *self-service*.

Requirements 2, 4 & 6. Taught together. Troops can attend **Friday night beginning about 8:30 pm in the dining hall**, which is strongly recommended for those in camp. At least one other class will be taught **Saturday morning at 9 am**.

Req. 7a – The courses!

Morning – Cross Country courses

Choice of 3. **Registration and Master Map** area on the **Hoover Amphitheater stage beginning at 9 am**. The **Start and Finish** areas will be located **between the Hoover wash house and stockade**, also open at **9 am**. (Rain location for both is the Museum).

Afternoon – Deaver's Challenge Score course

All participants will gather at the **Hoover Amphitheater at 2:45 pm** for map distribution and brief instruction. As soon as that's complete, there will be a mass start. **Finish is at Jamboree**.

Req. 7b – All groups must complete short comment card at the end of each course. Mass discussion @ **2:15 pm @ Hoover Amphitheater** to review morning courses. Mass discussion for score course at **8:00 pm at Hoover Amphitheater**, along with an overall review, and the announcement of the best times and scores. (Rain locations TBA)

Enjoy the ePunch course for fun, fitness and the "future": available 9 am - 1 pm at Start/Finish!

On the courses...

- At least one whistle per group.
- Groups must stay together!
- Groups not done with courses A or B after 90 minutes, may stop, return to Finish & receive credit.
- Responsibility for holding the **map MUST be rotated** so that all scouts have comparable turns; all scouts should still contribute ideas on the best way to get to next control.
- Groups may leave the trail; **BE CAREFUL & minimize impact on the environment (LNT)**.
- As always, don't go through occupied campsites or tented areas.
- "Hydrate or die."
- Try to re-use the same map for both the A and B courses, if possible.
- Adults are welcome to hit the courses, but scouts get priority on start times.
