Camp Tuscazoar receives grant for Hoover Lodge roof repair

The Herbert W. Hoover Foundation in Canton has approved a grant request by the Camp Tuscazoar Foundation for the repair of the metal roof on Hoover Lodge.

In a letter to the Foundation, chairman Herbert W. Hoover, Jr. said, "It gives me great pleasure to inform you that the Herbert W. Hoover Foundation voted to approve the Camp Tuscazoar grant request. Hoover Lodge is named in honor of Frank G. Hoover, a North Canton industrialist who financed the building's construction in 1949. It stands on the site of the first Pipestone camp honors ceremony. Originally designed to serve as a training center, the building is the largest of Camp Tuscazoar's cabins and is used by youth groups nearly every weekend from September to May.

Dover Dam Weekend to offer emergency preparedness demonstrations

Campsites are filling up quickly for the 1993 Dover Dam Weekend, scheduled for April 30-May 2. This year, the activities will focus on emergency preparedness instruction and demonstration. The Metro Life Flight unit from Cleveland may make a special appearance, weather permitting. Other activities will feature the Tuscarawas County Sheriff's K-9 unit, the Fairfield Township Fire and Rescue Department and a water rescue demonstration by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR).

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will offer tours of Dover Dam, Foundation trustee Tracy Farrall will discuss the Indian carving made by his father, Rex Farrall, in the late 1920s and canoe trips will be available at reduced rates at the NTR Canoe Livery in Bolivar.

Saturday afternoon, Scoutmaster Bob Hahn will lead vespers at Pioneer Point, offering first-time Tuscazoar campers an opportunity to place a stone on the great pile. A campfire filled with songs, skits and possibly a little magic will complete the activities.

The cost is \$3 per person. Camping and canoeing fees are additional. Tent sites are still available. For information and reservations, contact the camp at 216/859-2288.
