

A proud history at Camp Tuscazoar

The first entrance to Camp Tuscazoar was a pole tower constructed in 1926 near Pioneer Point, the main entrance to camp at that time. The pole tower was replaced two years later with a replica of a fort palisades gate.

In 1965, a stockade was built at its current location by members of the Pipestone program and strongly resembled its predecessor. The stockade was built as a memorial to Dudley Unkefer, an understudy of George M. Deaver, the council's first Scout Executive. Mr. Unkefer took over as Scout Executive in 1949 and resigned in 1957 to advance his Scouting career.

In 1998, the stockade had to be rebuilt once again. Today, hundreds of youth and adults pass through these gates each year to explore the riches of Tuscazoar, just as their predecessors have throughout the years. Please help us keep this tradition alive and consider a donation to support rebuilding and improving this symbol of Camp Tuscazoar.





The first stockade entrance at Camp Tuscazoar was constructed in the early 1920's. Since then, at least two other similar entrances were built to welcome campers. Thousands have passed through these gates and have read the sign that says, "You are a stranger here but once."

The time has come once again to restore this symbol of Camp Tuscazoar. The Camp Tuscazoar Foundation is hoping to construct another stockade, complete with a crossover bridge, in time for the camp's 100th anniversary in 2020.

Our intention is to construct this stockade in such a manner that it will last for many years. We will be reusing the original gate hardware to maintain the historic look. The crossover bridge will be replicated to match the old one so that troops will once again be able to use this structure for their crossover ceremonies!

This will be a grassroots campaign. We believe the supporters of Camp Tuscazoar will be able to raise the needed funds for this project.
